The year of 2021 was a splendid year that is destined to be recorded in the history. The Communist Party of China celebrated its centennial this year. China has achieved a comprehensive victory in poverty eradication and has completed the arduous task of eradicating abject poverty. The focus of work related to the issues of "Agriculture, Countryside and farmers" has historically shifted from poverty alleviation to rural revitalization in all dimensions. 2021 is the first year of China's "14th Five-Year Plan", the first year of shifting its focus to consolidating and expanding the achievements of poverty alleviation and comprehensively promoting rural revitalization. In 2021, with the historical moment of the intersection of the "two centenary goals", the CPC led and united the people of all ethnic groups to embark on a new journey of building a modern socialist country in an all-round way, and forge forward on the road of realizing the great rejuvenation of China.

Looking back, on March 13, 1989, under the care and leadership of the Central Committee of CPC, the State Council and the cordial care of the older generation of revolutionaries including Li Xiannian, Chen Junsheng, and Xiang Nan, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation (CFPA) was officially established in Beijing. Over the past 33 years, we have always been adhering to the founding purpose of CFPA, keeping in mind the original intention, and fully implementing the general guidelines. Oriented to poverty-stricken areas and focused on impoverished population, we have developed more than 100 influential, credible and practical poverty alleviation programs in fields of industry, education, health care and disaster relief. We have raised nearly RMB 9.2 billion in funds and supplies in total. They have benefited 57.1 million person-times in poverty and disaster-stricken areas.

We know quite well that we could not have made the achievements without the strong leadership and precise guidance of the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs, the National Administration for Rural Development, the Ministry of Civil Affairs and other relevant departments, as well as the enthusiastic participation and strong support of all sectors of society in the past 33 years. We hereby express our sincere thanks and great respect.

To focus on key tasks and serve overall needs, we made every effort to develop practical programs for poverty alleviation

CFPA came into being with the ushering of reform and opening up, and it complements the cause of poverty alleviation. The development history of CFPA over the past 30 more years is a mini-window of the history of China's reform and opening up, and is also the development history of China in poverty alleviation. The call for action in the "8-7 Poverty Alleviation Plan" at the CFPA's establishment, the "Outline of China's Poverty Alleviation & Rural Development (2001-2010)", and the 18th National Congress of the CPC mobilized all CPC members and social forces of China to implement the policies for targeted poverty alleviation and elimination. There is also a call to adhere to the general goal of poverty alleviation and to focus on poverty alleviation for deeply impoverished regions. We have always followed the policies and strategies from the Central Committee of CPC and the State Council for poverty alleviation and rural development, and are committed to the cause of poverty reduction and building a moderately prosperous society in an all-round way.

Going from poverty alleviation to rural revitalization, we have thoroughly realized the new historic mission and responsibility, and have been actively responding to the call of the Central Committee of CPC and the State Council. Based on our own advantages, we have adjusted our work priority and development focus in a timely manner, further improved our institutional management, created new project model and content, scientifically integrated resources and channels, and dedicated ourselves to the great undertaking of rural revitalization.

By virtue of innovation and tenacity, we strive to be the pioneer of poverty alleviation

For more than 30 years, we have been adhering to theme of implementing the major strategies and policies from the central committee of CPC for poverty alleviation, especially poverty elimination, and carried out work by focusing on key constraint factors of poverty alleviation concerning poverty-stricken areas and population. We made every effort to mobilize social forces to participate in poverty alleviation and elimination. We built platforms, gathered resources, entered remote mountains and visited villages, developed and carried out a series of poverty alleviation programs covering multiple sectors of industry including healthcare, education, disaster relief and targeted aid. We used new methods to explore solutions to poverty issues.

From project planning and design to implementation, we have always insisted on a detailed, comprehensive, and all-round management style covering

the whole process to ensure that the love and care from all participants are delivered as intended, so that practical results can be achieved.

Based on the overall work layout of national poverty alleviation and elimination, we have been adhering to the problem-oriented policy and addressing key constraint factors and outstanding problems in poverty alleviation for key regions and groups for more than 30 years. Through base-level inspection, we identified problems, developed plans, designed programs, prepared resources, and implemented with every effort. We directed further resources for poverty alleviation to impoverished areas, especially deeply-impoverished areas. We developed new programs tailored for the needs of poverty-stricken groups. The programs were accurately classified and efficiently implemented to effectively satisfy the diverse needs for poverty elimination and results consolidation. By virtue of years of experience in poverty alleviation at the front line, CFPA successively launched a series of large, effective, and influential philanthropy programs for poverty alleviation based on the needs of impoverished areas. These include poverty alleviation cooperation and training programs, Nutritious Meals Program, Panda Pack Program, Children Companion Plan, New Great Wall Scholarship Program, Backbone Project (Health Insurance for Poor Families' Labors), Emergency Aid, etc. Innovative projects have been implemented to help the poor increase their income sustainably. The programs include Poverty Alleviation Through E-Commerce, Bona Villa Program, Microfinance Program, and CFPA Pension Program.

For more than 30 years, we have been giving full play to the role of advantages and specialties of social organizations. We have been vigorously promoting the core values of socialism and the traditional virtues embedded in the Chinese Culture of helping the impoverished, the troubled, and each other. We dedicated ourselves to poverty reduction, spreading kindness, and fully spreading the power of love and kindness, which has expanded the social impact of poverty alleviation and elimination. We enthusiastically encouraged the donors and recipients to form a bond of mutual love and help, which has helped create vivid and touching stories of poverty alleviation in China. We organized a series of activities, such as "Annual Donors Conference" and "Seminars for Social Forces Participating in Poverty Alleviation" to expand the social impact of poverty alleviation and gather more resources to support comprehensive poverty eradication. We built open, transparent and convenient platforms and used new technologies and methods to expand channels for the public to participate in poverty alleviation. We launched a series of platforms, including One Yuan Donation Initiative, Great Walker, "Unite the Force for Good", Great Walker 100, Monthly Giving Initiative. They have greatly increased the engagement level of the public in poverty eradication.

To consolidate achievements and boost rural revitalization, we embarked on a journey of transformation and upgrading

In 2021, in order to better adapt to the new situation, new tasks and new requirements of the work related to the issues of "Agriculture, Countryside and Farmers" ("Three-rural Work"), we centered our work around the Three-rural Work and strived to make new progress. We have achieved an upgrade of the foundation and established new work policies.

Starting from supplies donation to the tsunami-stricken areas in Indonesia in 2005, we started our journey of international assistance and became the one of first batch of Chinese non-governmental organizations carrying out international charity programs. Since the 18th National Congress of the Communist Party of China, we have been actively responding to the Belt & Road Initiative, and upholding the philosophy of "love without borders and heartfelt connectivity among people". We have carried out international poverty reduction programs such as International Panda Pack program, Smiling Children program, and Solar Lantern Student Aid Program in 25 countries and regions, including Myanmar, Nepal, Ethiopia, Laos, Cambodia, Pakistan and Namibia. We have also cooperated with the United Nations Development Program (UNDP) on Disability Aid Poverty Reduction Training Program and International Vocational and Economic Development Program. We have strived to internationalize our work, and actively participated in high-end platform activities at home and abroad while accurately telling the stories of China's poverty reduction, demonstrating China's contributions to creating heartfelt connectivity among people, strengthening their base, and building a community with a shared future for mankind.

Remain true to original aspiration, keep the mission firmly in mind, forge ahead on a new journey

Remaining true to the original purpose of the establishment of CFFPA, we will keep in mind the mission of CFFPA and unite as one to accomplish new achievements with hard work in the new era of rural revitalization.

Adhering to the guidance of Xi Jinping Thought on Socialism with Chinese Characteristics for a New Era, especially the important instructions on work related to the issues of "Agriculture, Countryside and farmers" ("Three-rural Work"), we will make it our primary political responsibility and institutional mission to consolidate and expand the achievements of poverty alleviation and to give aid to rural revitalization, and implement the major decisions and policies by Central Committee of CPC on rural revitalization. Based on the advantages of CFFPA, we will play the role of social resource innovation and experiment for the implementation of charity programs for rural revitalization, also the role of guidance of social participation in rural revitalization.

On the one hand, we actively optimized existing sustainable development programs, such as the Bona Villa Program and the Shanpin e-Commune Program, to further diversify the development dimensions and enrich their content. On the other hand, we worked hard on research and design, and launched new programs concerning rural development, including Rural Livable Environment Charity Program and Rural Elderly Mutual Assistance Program. We will also strive to explore new development fields.

We will strive to make CFFPA an advanced institution with high transparency, credibility and influence. Since 2022, CFFPA has officially changed its name to the China Foundation For Rural Development (CFRD) with the approval of the upper-level authorities. At the starting point of the new era and new challenges, we will take practical actions to contribute to the rural development and philanthropic undertaking with Chinese characteristics, and make unremitting efforts to realize rural revitalization in all aspects, facilitate high-quality and efficient agriculture, and create a prosperous environment for farmers that is suitable for living and working.

In 2021, the focus of the work related to the issues of “Agriculture, Countryside and farmers” (“Three-rural Work”) is historically shifted from poverty alleviation to rural revitalization in all aspects. Based on our advantages, we adjusted our priority of work and focus of development in a timely manner, further improved institutional management, made great effort to develop new program model and content, and integrated resources and channels scientifically to fully participate in the great cause of rural revitalization.

In 2021, we transformed love from the public into nutritious meals to improve the health of children in underdeveloped areas, beautiful book bags for elementary school students, spacious school buildings, companion from child-care moms, convenient bridges over rivers, student aid, disaster relief, and programs promoting the development of rural industries, rural product sales, and rural labor healthcare, etc. We are gratified and proud of that.

In 2021, pursuant to the service philosophy of helping beneficiaries, donors and partners, we continued to strengthen our professional capacity and credibility, facilitate IT application and donor services, accelerate the application of mobile internet, and strive to discover, gather, spread, and empower kindness. As always, we repay the support from all sectors of society with our enthusiasm, great efforts, dedicated service and efficient work, and unreservedly convey the love and trust of donors to the brave and determined people in underdeveloped areas.



LIVELIHOOD DEVELOPMENT

With the development of cooperatives as the main focus and a benefit chain mechanism as the work priority, we introduced resources such as talents, technology, services and funds to help strengthen the connectivity of rural industries with the market to increase farmers' income. We implemented the strategy of example projects for demonstration and encouragement and achieved intended effects through example programs such as the Bona Villa Program and the agricultural income-generation project (Shanpin E-Commerce). Among the villages that have the necessary conditions, we have built them into comprehensive example villages in industry, talent, culture, and management by relying on industrial projects combined with other programs of CFPA.



Bona Villa Program

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Bona Villa Program in 2013 for villages in underdeveloped areas. In the villages that have necessary conditions for the program, we have gentrified traditional villages and old dwellings through overall planning and professional design. We have also maintained and improved the ecological environment in and around the villages to carry out rural tourism and promote the integrated development of rural primary, secondary, and tertiary industries. We have nurtured forerunners who can lead others in pursuing wealth and encouraged young people to return to the hometown for employment and entrepreneurship. By relying on the Two Village Committees and farmers' cooperatives, we have conducted democratic consultations to establish a revenue distribution mechanism with the cooperatives at the center that shares benefits among the members. We have applied a points-based systems for the development of rural civilization with an aim to build comprehensive rural revitalization demonstration villages with advanced industries, beautiful environment, vibrant culture, flexible mechanism and rich residents.

As of December 2021, the Bona Villa Program had received a cumulative donation of RMB 259 million, and has benefited 125,000 person-times.

In 2021, the Bona Villa Program received donations of RMB 52.36 million, expensed RMB 46.09 million, benefiting 20,000 person-times.

As of December 2021, the Program had launched 32 projects in total, benefitting 30 villages in 28 counties (districts) across 12 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government), including Hebei, Henan, Gansu, Shaanxi, Guizhou, Hunan, Sichuan, Jiangxi, Chongqing, Qinghai, Inner Mongolia, and Hubei.

Agricultural Income-Generation Project (Shanpin E-Commerce)

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Agricultural Income-Generation Project (Shanpin E-Commerce) in order to solve the problems of small production scale, scattered operation, short value chain and homogenous sales channels of rural industries in underdeveloped areas. Through cooperative incubation, quality control, brand building, and market promotion, the small farmer households in rural areas are encouraged to actively participate in production and development, which can increase income of farmers and village cooperatives by increasing market competitiveness and premium capacity of the product. It has helped consolidate and expand the achievements of poverty alleviation by building a rural industrial Agricultural Income-Generation service platform.

In 2021, donations of RMB 33.51 million were raised and RMB 32.87 million was spent for the program. By now, the Shanpin E-Commerce program has benefited 91 cooperatives in 77 counties (cities, districts) in 19 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government), including Sichuan, Yunnan, Shaanxi, Xinjiang, etc. Among them, 9 cooperatives were awarded the title of "Provincial Farmer Cooperative Demonstration" and 3 cooperatives were awarded the title of "National Farmer Cooperative Demonstration", 2 cooperatives were recognized by the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs as national examples of demonstration cooperatives. The program has benefitted 42,581 rural households. More than 100 categories of agricultural products have been developed and helped; 35 storage centers have been built in 14 provinces; 327,346.9 acres of quality control management demonstration bases have been established; the number of cumulative online views have exceeded 2.5 billion; the number of consumers who participated in the program and gave support have exceeded 2 million person-times.

TALENT DEVELOPMENT

Diverse forms of training systems and courses for different groups are established and developed by gathering resources from universities, scientific research institutes and professional training institutions to expand channels for the growth of rural talents and improve their overall capacity. Talent development programs aim to cultivate farmer talents, local experts, inheritors and entrepreneurs in various forms such as new farmers training, village cadres training, and entrepreneurial and employment talents training.





Young Farmer Entrepreneurship Development Program

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Young Farmer Entrepreneurship Development Program in 2019 to relieve the shortage of rural entrepreneurial talents in underdeveloped areas. The program aims to strengthen the management capabilities and market competitiveness of rural entrepreneurial leaders and promote rural talent nurturing and sustainable rural development by bringing together teachers from colleges and scientific research institutions through classroom teaching, on-site practical training, venture philanthropy investment, market support and other multi-dimensional and multi-level entrepreneurial empowerment and cultivation system.

As of December 2021, the Program had benefited more than 20 counties (cities, districts) in 10 provinces (municipality directly under the Central Government and autonomous regions). In 2021, the program carried out projects such as the new farmers training, cooperative incubation, and infrastructure construction and had raised funds of RMB 18.60 million. In 2021, 6 sessions of centralized training, 3 sessions of regional training, and more than 10 sessions of community training were held, with a total of 844 person-times of trainees. Twelve normal executive cooperatives are distributed in 12 counties (cities, districts) across 7 provinces (municipality directly under the Central Government and autonomous regions). The program has benefited 2,602 rural households, including 601 households with cooperative membership, totalling 8,591 person-times. Quality control management core bases under the Program occupying a total area of 3,430-mu (mu: Chinese unit of land measurement that is commonly 666.7 square metres) have been established.

Farmer Leadership Development Program

In 2021, under the guidance of the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs, the State-owned Assets Supervision and Administration Commission of the State Council, the National Administration for Rural Revitalization, the China Banking and Insurance Regulatory Commission and the China Securities Regulatory Commission, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation organized social forces to help with Rural Revitalization Exchange Training Sessions. In conjunction with the Party School of the Central Committee of the CPC, the Securities Association of China, China Minsheng Bank, Dongxing Securities, China Orient Asset Management Co., Ltd., China State Railway Group and COFCO Group. The program aims to elevate the professional capacity of personnel of all units participating in rural revitalization program and agriculture-related cadres, strengthen the support of talents for rural revitalization, and effectively help advance rural revitalization in all dimensions. In 2021, a total of 8 Rural Revitalization Exchange Training Sessions were held with the aid of social forces. A total of 4,717 person-times of representatives of agriculture-related cadres from central state organs, financial institutions, enterprises and institutions participated in the training.

To strengthen the weak links of rural construction, disaster prevention and mitigation, we have developed the programs to improve rural residents' convenience, safety and comfort by strengthening the disaster response capabilities of the residents in rural disaster-prone areas and creating better living environment and ecological environment.



Disaster Relief

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Disaster Relief program in 2003 to provide assistance to disaster-stricken people and areas, reduce disaster losses, strengthen community resilience, help affected people overcome difficulties, rebuild homes and help build livable villages through disaster reduction and prevention advocacy, disaster preparation, emergency rescue, transitional resettlement, post-disaster recovery and reconstruction.

Since the establishment of the Disaster Relief program in 2003, a total of 316 disaster relief operations have been carried out (including 25 winter relief operations for vulnerable groups), with RMB 1.708 billion of expenditure for disaster relief funds and supplies. The program has directly benefited 7.038 million people in 31 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government) across China,

In 2021, the Disaster Relief program carried out 27 disaster relief operations, raised RMB 66.75 million in funds and supplies and spent RMB 44.16 million, benefiting 524,400 people in 15 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government).

Henan Flood Disaster Relief Project

After the natural disaster of torrential rain on July 20, 2021 in Henan, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation fully implemented the important instructions of General Secretary Xi Jinping on flood control and disaster relief work, launched the disaster response plan immediately to carry out emergency rescue operation, making every effort to help the people in the disaster-stricken areas to restore production and life.

After its disaster response plan was started on July 20, 2021, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation dispatched a total of 58 people in 3 groups to the disaster-stricken area, established the "China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation Henan Flood Relief Frontline Headquarters" in Gongyi City, Zhengzhou City, Henan Province, and set up 5 centers including a rescue center, a feedback and dissemination center, a fundraising development center, a reconstruction planning center, and a logistics center. We set up seven front-line workstations in Hui County of Xinxiang City, Fengquan District of Xinxiang City, Gongyi City, Xingyang City, Luoyang City, Xinmi City and Hebi City to carry out front-line supplies reception and distribution, transfer of affected people, danger identification, disaster investigation, environment sanitization, hot meal supply, dredging, etc. As of December 20, 2021, the Henan flood relief operation initiated by China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation had received support and donation totaling RMB 428 million from 215 enterprises, 6 charity platforms, and 2.54 million people, benefiting 7 cities and 20 counties (cities, districts), including Zhengzhou, Xinxiang, Hebi, Luoyang, and Xuchang. At the same time, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation, in conjunction with 13 humanitarian rescue network partners, mobilized 30 rescue teams with a total of 267 members to carry out rescue missions with the help of rescue vehicles, rubber boats, underwater sonar and other water area rescue equipment. More than 2,200 people were transferred and rescued. In Henan Province, more than 220,000 portions of food supplies such as grain, flour, oil, dried noodles, and bottled water were distributed; more than 100,000 sets of emergency supplies such as humanitarian emergency boxes, folding beds, mats and quilts, rubber shoes, and feminine products were distributed; more than 7,000 packages of emergency equipment such as flashlights, mobile power supplies, generators, water purifiers, and fog machines were distributed for multiple resettlement sites to ensure basic living needs of the disaster-stricken people in multiple aspects. According to actual needs of the disaster-stricken areas to rebuild homes, we creatively designed the Home Restoration – Work-Relief Home Clean-Up Program which organized villagers to carry out village clean-up and public services through labor subsidies, benefiting 624 program villages in Henan Province. A total of 80 sets of excavators and loaders were donated by the Home Restoration - Equipment Aid Program; 3 sets of water purification equipment were installed for the disaster-stricken villages to ensure drinking water safety after the disaster; 6 hot meal supply sites were set up to provide lunch and dinner for the trapped people and emergency repair workers. A total of more than 107,300 local residents received our service. In order to prevent post-disaster pandemic, disinfection and pandemic prevention work were carried out in streets and communities, covering a disinfected area of 2,156,100 square meters.

According to actual needs of the disaster-stricken areas and the wishes of the donors, we carried out programs such as the bridge construction Project, Sunshine Runway, Clinics, and Farm House Subsidies to provide infrastructure support for the recovery of production and life of residents in the disaster-stricken areas; we carried out school disaster reduction classroom program, town/village disaster preparedness warehouse program and resilient village program to strengthen the disaster prevention and response capabilities of people in disaster-stricken areas.

Actions Against COVID-19

Considering insufficient pandemic prevention capacity, shortage of pandemic prevention and living supplies, and stress suffered by anti-pandemic personnel in the affected areas, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Actions Against COVID-19 program in 2020. Through donation of funds and supplies to anti-pandemic personnel and the people affected by the pandemic, CFPA provided supplies and psychological intervention, supported the anti-pandemic personnel in their work, and helped the affected people overcome the difficulties and return to normal production and life.

In 2021, under the guidance of the Ministry of Civil Affairs, the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs and the National Health Commission, and according to the wishes of the donors and the actual situation of local pandemic prevention, we provided funds assistance to Shiyuan City, Hubei Province and Xilin Gole League, Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region for purchase of protective clothing, isolation gowns, medical masks, testing reagents and other anti-pandemic supplies, benefiting 28 hospitals and 4 CDCs in 6 counties (cities and districts). In 2021, we raised funds and supplies with a value of RMB 990,700 and spent RMB 9,628,500 for the program, directly benefiting 424,700 people.

Two rescue teams were dispatched to Xinle City, Hebei Province to carry out pandemic prevention and disinfection work. The disinfected area reached about 1.06 million square meters. Through our partners in Shijiazhuang, we distributed 500 COVID-19 prevention boxes to front-line social workers and volunteers and bought 500 copies of COVID-19 prevention insurance for them.

We dispatched teams to the front line of the COVID-19 pandemic prevention and control in Tonghua, Jilin Province, and established a humanitarian aid Jilin Province pandemic prevention and control command center in Changchun City. By supporting local institutions, we gave 700 sets of bedding, 3,000 protective masks, 9,232 sets of protective clothing, 5 tons of disinfectant, 14,942 pairs of cotton gloves, 195,000 pairs of medical examination gloves, 200,000 disposable medical surgical masks and other COVID-19 pandemic prevention supplies benefiting 28 communities including Qianjin Community, Xiguan Community and Xichang Community in Tonghua City, and 2 hospitals: Tonghua Central Hospital and Tonghua Traditional Chinese Medicine Hospital.

Disaster Prevention and Risk Reduction


China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Disaster Prevention and Risk Reduction program in 2014. The program aims to raise public awareness on disaster reduction and prevention and enhance self-rescue and assistance capabilities through activities. It also aims to improve rural disaster response capabilities and development resilience by building disaster relief supply reserves, so as to contribute to the construction of livable countryside.

For disaster reduction advocacy, we issued the Research Report on Public Awareness of Disaster Prevention and Reduction in China, and the Research Report on Status Quo of Disaster Prevention and Reduction Education for Primary-school students in China, and published the Guidelines for Disaster Prevention and Reduction Education for Primary-school students; we carried out disaster reduction and prevention advocacy programs such as “SAY NO to disasters”, school disaster reduction classroom, college student disaster reduction officer, No. 1 village disaster responder. For disaster prevention and preparedness, according to the characteristics of different disasters in different stages and different relief needs, we have established a multi-variety, diffuse and fast-

arriving supplies disaster preparedness system, and a nationwide disaster relief partner system—the Humanitarian Aid Network, and developed aid plans for different needs – Program Pool.

In 2021, the Disaster Prevention and Risk Reduction Program carried out “SAY NO to Disasters”—512 National Disaster Reduction and Prevention Community Charity Activity, School Disaster Reduction Classroom program, and “Smart Classroom” program. We raised funds and supplies with a value of RMB 778,700, spent RMB 1.41 million, benefiting 42,700 people in 8 counties (cities, districts) of 5 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government).



Ecological Afforestation Program

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Ecological Afforestation Program in 2018. With the financial aid of the Ant Group Ant Forest Program and other donating companies, the Program aims to plant suitable trees for ecologically fragile areas and improve the vegetation ecology. It helps increase income for the low-income groups by providing them jobs of caring for the vegetation, thus contributing to the sustainable development of rural ecology.

As of 2021, the Ecological Afforestation Program had raised donations of RMB 100 million, benefiting 16 counties (cities, districts) and 11 cities of 3 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government), including Inner Mongolia, Gansu and Shanxi. 222,991 mu (mu: Chinese unit of land measurement that is commonly 666.7 square metres) of vegetation has been planted (afforestation area), cumulatively benefiting 143,000 people and offering opportunities for 7,362 people to increase income.

In 2021, the Ecological Afforestation Program raised donations of RMB 60.20 million, and spent RMB 47.28 million in funds and supplies. The program benefited 87,590 people in 12 counties (cities, districts) and 8 cities of 2 provinces, including Gansu and Shanxi.

Rural Infrastructure Building Program

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Rural Infrastructure Building Program in 2017. With financial aid, the program aims to support the construction of small and medium-sized public facilities such as bridges, roads, school buildings, and sanitation facilities in villages in underdeveloped areas, so as to improve local public facilities and offer convenience for the production and daily life of local residents, contributing to the construction of livable villages.

In 2021, the program raised donations of RMB 7.39 million, and spent RMB 18.42 million, benefiting 29 counties (cities, districts) in 13 provinces (municipality directly under the Central Government and autonomous regions). It also benefited 171,500 people by assisting with the construction of 18 convenience bridges, Sunshine Runways in 15 schools, student dormitories of 10 schools and high school clinics of 11 schools.




Domestic Panda Pack Project

In 2009, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation, China Post Group Corporation and The Movie Channel jointly launched the Domestic Panda Pack Project. The project aims to realize children's childhood dreams and improve their learning and living conditions by donating the packs and sending one-to-one care to children.

As of December 31, 2021, the Domestic Panda Pack Project had received social donations of RMB 816 million from more than 2.32 million caring individuals and 170,000 caring companies as well as more than 10 billion online donations. The project have distributed a total of 6,781,500 Student Art Packs, 726,600 Student Warm Packs, 32,000 Student Life Packs, and 31,000 School Packs, benefiting 7,574,800 students of 34,593 schools in 936 counties of 31 provinces, as well as 6,549 families.

In 2021, the project raised donations of RMB 31.32 million, spent RMB 55.04 million, and cumulatively distributed a total of 326,546 Student Art Packs and 92,854 Student Warm Packs, benefiting 419,400 pupils of 1,822 schools in 94 counties of 23 provinces.




Moving Forward Program

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Moving Forward Program in 2014. The program aims to help rural students develop in all dimensions by introducing core literacy courses and building study zones. It also aims to stimulate internal motivation and innovation of principals and teachers through training, exchange workshops and financial support. Taking county as a unit, the program continues to be carried out in rural primary schools to promote the overall improvement of rural education.

As of December 31, 2021, the program had received donations of RMB 139 million, and the number of direct beneficiaries had reached 141,800 people, including 136,778 rural students (including transfer and graduated students) and 5,007 rural teachers of 456 schools in 11 counties (cities, districts) of 5 provinces, including Guizhou, Yunnan, Sichuan, Guangxi, and Henan Province.

In 2021, the Program raised donations of RMB 42.23 million, spent RMB 39.15 million, benefiting 112,868 rural students (including transfer and graduated students) and 4,709 rural teachers of 428 schools in 8 counties of 3 provinces, including Guizhou, Yunnan and Henan.

New Great Wall Scholarship Program for Undergraduate Students

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the New Great Wall Scholarship Program for Undergraduate Students in 2002. The program aims to help college students from families with financial stress difficulties complete their college studies and improve their comprehensive abilities through financial aid and talent support activities. It jointly builds the Great Wall of Talents in the new era with college students by guiding them to actively give back to the society and pass on the social care.

As of December 31, 2021, the program had received donations of RMB 316.7501 million, benefiting 146,236 students in more than 600 colleges and universities in 31 provinces. At the same time, the New Great Wall Self-improvement Societies were established in 104 universities to provide a platform for students to become talents.

In 2021, the Program raised donations of RMB 11.84 million, spent RMB 10.49 million, directly benefiting 3,379 people from 147 universities and 15 counties of 29 provinces across the country.




New Great Wall Scholarship Program for High-School Students


China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the New Great Wall Scholarship Program for High-School Students in 2007. The program aims to help students from families with financial difficulties complete their studies and improve their comprehensive abilities through financial aid coupled with talent management services.

As of December 31, 2021, the program had received donations of RMB 442.6126 million, and spent RMB 372.8165 million, directly benefiting 190,000 people, including 69,400 students from families with financial difficulties who have received scholarships and talent services. The program have benefited 557 high schools in 426 counties (cities, districts) of 28 provinces.

In 2021, the Program raised donations of RMB 92.86 million, spent RMB 66.33 million, benefiting 277 counties of 23 provinces. A total of 617 scholarship classes were established for high school students in 329 high schools, providing scholarships and talent services for 35,843 students from families with financial difficulties.

New Great Wall Vocational Education Empowerment Project

The China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the New Great Wall Vocational Education Empowerment Project in 2021. The program aims to help students complete studies and improve their career skills by providing financial aid, developing high-quality vocational courses, providing career guidance, and internship opportunities and other actions.

In 2021, the program raised donations of RMB 16.3356 million (including RMB 3 million of donations transferred from 2020), and spent RMB 4.3349 million, providing financial aid and empowerment training for 1,250 vocational education students of 26 secondary and higher vocational colleges in 5 provinces.

Empowering Children, Enlightening the Future

To promote comprehensive quality development of rural children, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Empowering Children, Enlightening the Future program in 2021. The program aims to improve children's literacy level and help rural children develop in all dimensions through children companion program, rural digital classroom programs as well as digital, aesthetic education coupled with reading and other content.

The program, through cooperation with Yum China and Lile Education, has the purpose of popularization of programming education in rural schools, elevating the digital capabilities of the schools, broadening the horizons of rural primary-school students through "Internet + AI education popularization", computer donation, teacher empowerment, and programming classes. It offers opportunity for rural children to develop in all dimensions and has benefited about 250 schools in 5 provinces.

We conjunction with Lego Group, offered donated Lego toy kits to rural children, especially left-behind and vulnerable children, through the "Build to Give" activity. Thus, the children have opportunities to have a creative play experience, enabling them to learn and grow through play experiences. By now, LEGO Group has donated more than 267,000 LEGO toy kits, benefiting nearly 350,000 children in 25 counties (cities, districts) of 9 provinces (municipality directly under the Central Government and autonomous regions) including Yunnan, Guizhou, Hubei, etc.

We cooperate with Beijing One Way Street Foundation to carry out aesthetics education for children in rural areas so as to improve children's literacy level.


Rural Education Development Program

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Rural Education Development Program in 2017. The program aims to improve rural educational resources and environment, and facilitate continuous improvement of rural education level by offering support for rural schools, teacher teams, students and families through construction of school infrastructure, capacity development of and financial aid to rural teachers and students.

As of December 31, 2021, the program had raised donations of RMB 126.7245 million, cumulatively benefiting 889,000 people (person-times). In 2021, the program continued to focus on improving the level of rural education as the primary objective, and carried out small and medium-sized programs such as scholarship programs and construction of schools and supporting facilities. At the same time, China Southern Power Grid (CSG) and China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation jointly launched the CSG Zhixing Bookstore program with a planned donation of RMB 150 million to build no less than 300 CSG Zhixing Bookstores from 2021 to 2025 in five provinces (districts), including Yunnan, Guizhou, Guangxi, Guangdong and Hainan. The program aims to arouse students' interest in reading, expand the scope of reading, and elevate the quality of reading by creating a friendly reading environment, updating books, and

strengthening teachers' leading ability in reading, so as to help rural education revitalize through reading.

In 2021, the Rural Education Development Program raised donations of RMB 47.15 million, and spent RMB 22.1119 million in funds and supplies, directly benefiting 466,700 people (person-times) in 40 counties (cities and districts) of 15 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government).

Nutritious Meals Program

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Nutritious Meals Program in 2008. The program aims to improve school meal quality, help children increase nutrition intake, and continue to improve children's health status. It contributes to rural revitalization through Nutritious Meals, Love Kitchen, nutrition knowledge education and material aid and other aid methods.

As of December 31, 2021, the program had raised funds and supplies with a value of RMB 482 million, benefiting 141 counties (cities, districts) of 74 cities (prefectures) in 18 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government), including Yunnan, Guizhou, Hebei, Xinjiang, Anhui, etc. It has provided about 72.71 million servings of Nutritious Meals and equipped 3,074 schools with Love Kitchen equipment, benefiting more than 1.515 million students.

In 2021, the program raised funds and supplies with a value of RMB 62.8036 million and spent RMB 51.3303 million (The cumulative program income and expenditure include the Love Kitchens of COVID-19 program and flood program; the project income and expenditure of current year do not include the Love Kitchens of COVID-19 program and flood program), benefiting 41 counties (cities and districts) of 28 cities (prefectures) of 11 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government), including Yunnan, Guizhou, etc. The program provided about 9.6 million servings of Nutritious Meals and equipped 386 schools with Love Kitchen equipment, benefiting 181,000 people (person-times).

Children Companion Plan

In 2015, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Children Companion Plan. Through training of rural women, we carried out the care and protection program for rural children in the form of “one person, one family, and one bond”. A village-level guardianship network for left-behind and vulnerable children has been established with Children Companion Mother as the focus, Children Companion Home as the platform, and the County-Level Horizontal Linkage Mechanism as the guarantee. The program aims to ensure that child welfare services are delivered to the last mile. In 2018, the Children Companion Plan became the Alibaba charity strategic cooperation project.

As of December 31, 2021, the program had raised funds and supplies with a value of RMB 145 million, in addition to local supporting funds of RMB 26.3135 million. Through joint efforts of the Sichuan Provincial Committee of the Communist Youth League, the Department of Civil Affairs of Guizhou Province, the Jiangxi Charity Federation, the Department of Civil Affairs of Yunnan Province, the Department of Civil Affairs of Hubei Province, the Anhui Jianghuai Charity Foundation and the Department of Civil Affairs of Shaanxi Province, the “Children Companion Plan” has been carried out in 1,379 villages of 106 counties in 10 provinces, benefiting nearly 750,000 children. The project has been appreciated and affirmed by local government, partners, children and parents.

In 2021, the program raised funds and supplies with a value of RMB 37.28 million and spent 38.58 million, benefiting 1,135 villages of 88 counties in 10 provinces, including Guizhou, Jiangxi, Yunnan, Hubei, Anhui, Shaanxi, Sichuan, Shanxi, Hebei and Henan. It collected and solved 131,700 cases of children's welfare security needs, organized 100,800 Child Companion Home activities. 718,900 children (person-times) and 98,700 parents (person-times) participated in the activities. The Plan carried out 29 sessions of Children Companion Mother training and guidance, and a total of 1,701 people (person-times) participated in the training.




Backbone Project (Health Insurance for Poor Families' Labors)

In order to solve the problem of returning to poverty due to illness or accident in underdeveloped areas and under the guidance of the National Administration for Rural Revitalization (formerly the Poverty Alleviation Office of the State Council) and the National Health Commission, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation, Alibaba Philanthropy, Alipay Philanthropy and Ant Financial Service Insurance Platform jointly launched the Backbone Project (Health Insurance for Poor Families' Labors) in 2017. The program aims to provide comprehensive health care and accident insurance for low-income groups through special public welfare insurance to reduce the occurrence of returning to poverty due to illness or accident. In 2021, the Backbone Project (Health Insurance for Poor Families' Labors) was improved and upgraded according to the guidance of experts and various sectors of society. It will continue to provide comprehensive illness-specific or accident-specific public welfare insurance for low-income groups aged 18-60. The program has been granted the 11th “China Charity Award”.

As of December 31, 2021, the program had raised funds and supplies with a value of around RMB 370 million in total, benefiting more than 13.35 million of low-income population in 100 counties (cities, districts) of 12 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government), including Yunnan, Guizhou, Shaanxi, etc. A total of 191,800 claims under the program were settled, with a cumulative settlement amount of RMB 290 million, effectively reducing the hospitalization burden of low-income population.

In 2021, the program raised funds and supplies with a value of RMB 30.48 million, and spent RMB 34.03 million, providing health care for more than 1.96 million people (person-times) in 32 counties (cities and districts) of 6 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government).

Critical Illness Relief Project

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Critical Illness Relief Project in 2019. By providing medical and rehabilitation subsidies, living allowances and other comprehensive relief funds for low-income groups in underdeveloped areas, the program helps relieve the beneficiaries' pressure of seeking medical care and enhance their confidence in life, thus reducing county-level incidence of return to poverty due to illness.

As of December 31, 2021, the program had raised funds and supplies with a value of RMB 22.8418 million, benefiting 15 counties of 5 provinces, including Yunnan, Guizhou, Sichuan, Hubei and Shaanxi, and providing comprehensive fund support such as medical treatment, rehabilitation subsidies, and living allowances for 1,981 seriously ill villagers.

In 2021, the program raised donations of RMB 5.24 million and spent RMB 14.53 million, benefiting 11 counties of 5 provinces, including Yunnan, Guizhou, Sichuan, Hubei and Shaanxi. It also provided comprehensive fund support such as medical treatment, rehabilitation subsidies, and living allowances for 1,877 seriously ill villagers.

Rural Healthcare Program

By providing medical aid, equipment & facilities and material assistance for, and giving training to rural medical personnel in underdeveloped areas, the Rural Healthcare Program has improved the level of medical services in underdeveloped areas and elevated the health level of local residents.

Aiming to reduce mother and infant mortality rate and improve the protection of life and health of mothers and infants in underdeveloped areas, the Mother and Infant Safety Program has successively launched initiatives such as the Mother and Infant Safety 120 Days Initiative, the See Brightness Initiative, the Critical Illness Program, etc. From January 1, 2000 to December 31, 2021, both the received donations and expenditure of the Mother and Infant Safety Program have exceeded RMB 167 million. The program benefited 792,000 people in 27 counties (cities, districts) of 11 provinces (municipality directly under the Central Government and autonomous regions), including Yunnan, Chongqing, Fujian, Ningxia, Anhui, Sichuan, Shanxi, Hebei, Hunan, Liaoning and Beijing.

● Mother and Infant Safety Program

In 2021, the Mother and Infant Safety Program benefited 21,000 people(times) in 5 counties of 4 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government), including Yunnan, Chongqing, Fujian and Ningxia. Furthermore, 160 people received Hospitalization & Delivery Subsidies For Pregnant Women and 21,000 children (person-times) received subsidies for vision screening, correction, spectacles and surgery.

● Poverty-Stricken Farmers Aid Program

In 2021, the income of the Poverty-Stricken Farmers Aid Program was RMB 1.0127 million, and the expenditure was RMB 951,300. The program benefited 88 counties (cities, districts) of 13 provinces, including Gansu, Guizhou, Hebei, etc., with a total of 442 beneficiaries. In addition to financially supporting these families, the program gives them confidence to face life in the future.

● Health Aid Program

In 2021, Health Aid Program had a revenue of RMB 15 million, and expended RMB 10.8 million, benefiting 311,200 people from 3 counties of Gansu Province.





Rural Doctor Training Program

The China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Rural Angel Project in 2020. By providing medical service tool kits and empowerment training for rural doctors in underdeveloped areas, the program will help gradually improve the medical equipment for rural doctors in underdeveloped areas. It will also support the capacity building of rural doctors, improve the level of rural medical services, and provide more solid health protection for rural residents.

By the end of 2021, the program had raised a total of RMB 5.7995 million in donations, with a total of 2,765 beneficiaries (person-times), providing capacity building and angel patrol package support for 7 counties (cities, districts) in 4 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government).

In 2021, the project raised funds of 1.64 million and spent 1.23 million, benefiting 630 people (person-times) in 3 provinces (municipality directly under the Central Government) including Chongqing, Shanxi and Sichuan.

Internet-Based Philanthropy

● Alibaba Philanthropy

In 2021, the China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation raised RMB 123 million through Alibaba Philanthropy Baby and RMB 11.9447 million through online philanthropy stores. The donations supported a number of charity programs such as the Domestic (International) Panda Pack program, the Backbone Project (Health Insurance for Poor Families' Labors), the Children Companion Plan, the New Future -High School Students Program, the Smiling Children Program and the joint fundraising activities of social organizations. In 2021, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation became one of the first batch of rotating institutions of Alibaba XIN Yibai, which will help with development of the industry through joint contribution.

During the 95 Charity Week in 2021, the platform held the live broadcast night event with theme of "Love The Land, Be Philanthropic" to contribute to rural revitalization. We invited celebrities Yao Chen and Papi Jiang to join the live broadcast room to introduce the New Future -High School Students Program and the Children Companion Plan, which helped with the promotion of the program by advocating for caring netizens to participate.

In 2021, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation and Tencent jointly carried out the "Magic Street for Spring Festival Commodities", "Post Love 320 Event", "520 Do Good for Love", "Hungry 24 Smiling Children", and "Running Water Initiative Charity Day Joint Fundraising Action" and many other themed fundraising activities, raising RMB 109 million through Tencent platform. Tencent Foundation and China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation have reached agreements on cooperation for a number of construction programs based on social needs. The Warm Home Program provides diverse forms of support such as Warm Packs and Pandemic Prevention Packs for front-line volunteers and troubled families. The Starlight Library Program aims to solve the issue of primary-school students lagging behind in reading ability and content.

During the 99 Charity Day activity (From September 1, 2021 to September 9, 2021), China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation invited more than one hundred social organizations and corporate partners to actively participate in the Tencent Charity Platform 95 Common Wealth Special Event and 99 Charity Day fundraising activities, conveying care to troubled population through 61 charity programs. We actively responded to the national rural revitalization strategy and the common prosperity action and raised from 1.4 million individuals RMB 45.312 million of donation funds, which is used to support underdeveloped areas and vulnerable groups.

In 2021, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation made a call for donation on the Alipay charity donation platform, and raised RMB 110 million. The funds were used to support a number of flagship programs such as Panda Pack, Backbone Project (Health Insurance for Poor Families' Labors), and Nutritious Meals Program, etc. We also carried out activities such as "Spring-Festival Five Blessings " and "Annual Good People and Good Deeds Gala", calling on enterprises and the public to actively participate in Ant Manor, Ant New Village, Walker Donation, Points Donation and other charitable actions.

● ByteDance Philanthropy

In November 2021, the ByteDance charity platform was officially launched and implored users of Douyin, Toutiao and Xigua Video to actively participate in fundraising for the Moving Forward Program and Nutritious Meals Program, raising a total of RMB 3.04 million. In the "Charity Program Spokesperson" activity, a group of outstanding charity influencers such as @Pengcheng Principal, @Teacher Xia who teaches English, and @wumengshanxia Vice Principal stood out and consistently voiced for charity programs.

Promoting Philanthropic Participation by Boosting Consumption

In recent years, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation has been constantly exploring and innovating the methods for enterprise cooperation. We promoted charity through consumption by utilizing the advantages of enterprises to carry out fundraising activities and by innovative forms of customer donation and enterprise matching.

Since 2020, PepsiCo has cooperated with China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation and Wumart Group for two consecutive years to carry out the "Wumart Promotes Agriculture, Duodian Happy Things" charity activity. We supported specialty industries in underdeveloped areas through PepsiCo's product sales donation, and cooperated with Wumart for acquisition and sales at the same time.

From July 1, 2021 to August 31, 2021, for every pack of PepsiCo's Lay's potato chips purchased by consumers in any of more than 500 Wumart stores across the country or from online Duodian platform, PepsiCo donated RMB 0.1 for charity funds. A total of about RMB 1.8 million was donated through the event. Moreover, PepsiCo's Lay's brand donated RMB 200,000, and PepsiCo donated additional funds of USD 250,000 (donation managed by Give2Asia). The funds are used to support about 1,800 Hebei paddock farmer households in their pursuit of wealth by increasing their potato output. During harvest season, Wumart will purchase potatoes planted by farmers at market prices to help develop the industry and create a "from farm to table" method of helping farmers.

In September 2021, Quaker, a nutrition brand under PepsiCo, cooperated with China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation and Tencent Philanthropy to launch the "The meal is full of love" charity campaign, aiming to raise awareness of consumers on the malnutrition problems of children in underdeveloped areas and to promote the health benefits of oat meal. The campaign has been promoted and advertised through all online and offline platforms such as outdoor advertising, Tencent News, WeChat, Weibo, and e-commerce platforms. Since the launch, the campaign has accumulated 200 million views, and interacted with customers more than 4 million times. In this "The meal is full of love" charity campaign, Quaker donated 111,157 Quaker oat products to children in Baoshan City and Pu'er City of Yunnan Province to improve the nutrition intake of children in mountainous areas, enabling them to embrace the future with a stronger body.

From August 25, 2021 to September 10, 2021, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation and Yonghui's own brand "Tianqu" cooperated for the third year in a row and launched the "Yonghui Tianqu Nutritious Meals" sub-program through Tencent platform, and called on the whole society to help improve the nutritional status of children in underdeveloped areas in China through online advertisements and simultaneous promotion campaign in 389 offline stores.

Monthly Giving Initiative

In 2021, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation communicated the concept of "More Giving, More Joy" which advocates the public to donate in small amounts every month, through multiple approaches such as channel cooperation, event operation, content operation, etc. As of December 31, 2021, monthly donors have reached 78,390.

In 2021, two seasons of Philanthropic Communications Officer were carried out. More than 30,000 young people signed up to be communications officers, raising charity awareness of 330,000 people and more than 2,700 caring people were invited to join the Monthly Giving Initiative to provide continuous nutrition support for rural children. Zhang Yishan, Zheng Kai, Lin Gengxin, Liu Mintao, Rayza and other celebrities voiced their support for charity. A total of 317 people have been invited to be torchbearers for monthly giving and 866 people have been mobilized to join the Monthly Giving Initiative through sharing of thoughts, impressions and emotions among friends and family. We, in conjunction with the education foundations of 3 provinces and cities, implored 77 high schools to establish the Alumni Monthly Giving Initiative, and nearly 10,000 alumni have been mobilized to participate in the Monthly Giving Initiative to help the students of their alumni. We have promoted Monthly Giving Initiative through cooperation with 8 companies, including Codemao, Uncle Kai's Stories, Harvest Foundation, Jianzhi Keji, 24 media platforms such as CCTV12, Sohu News, ZAKER, Gongyi.ifeng.com, Dadi Cinema Group, and 19 We-media influencer accounts. 77 events were organized in 2021, including the new monthly donors welcome parties, annual gathering, and philanthropy visits to program areas.




Great Walker, One Step One Change

To mobilize more people to participate in rural revitalization and to innovate the form of participation, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the “Great Walker, One Step One Change” initiative in 2014. The Initiative encourages the public to form a 4-person team to overcome difficulties and complete the set mileage within specified time. We mobilized people to participate in charity program in the form of donation or consumption with the belief that “every step will bring about change”, which promotes the development of rural industries and contributes to rural revitalization.

As of December 31, 2021, we have held 19 events in 8 sessions with the “Great Walker, One Step One Change” initiative. A total of 16,000 teams from more than 150 cities in more than 10 countries signed up for the events. 39,800 person-times participated in the walk, 27,700 person-times completed the challenge, and 33,100 people(times) of volunteers and staff provided services. A total of RMB 57.9895 million was raised for charity and agricultural aid, and 618,400 person-times anticipated in donation and assistance through consumption. The initiative was supported by more than 100 enterprises, more than 60 celebrities and more than 100 media platforms.

In 2021, a “Great Walker, One Step One Change” event was successfully held in Chengdu City. At the same time, preparation for the “Great Walker, One Step One Change” event in Beijing was carried out. A total of 1,972 teams signed up for the event, and 2,424 people successfully completed the challenge. At the same time, the launch of the 2021 “Great Walker in China. Good from Start” online campaign attracted 51,000 participants. In 2021, a total of 36,500 person-times participated in donation and assistance through consumption for helping farmers, and RMB 5.71 million was raised. Furthermore, RMB 558,400 was used for the Panda Package program; RMB123,900 was used for the New Great Wall Scholarship Program for High-School Students program; RMB 762,700 was used for the Love Kitchen program; RMB 10,800 was used for the Nutritious Meals program; RMB 565,500 was used for the Philanthropy for Everyone program; RMB 476,400 was used for the e-commerce poverty alleviation program; RMB 681,400 was used to help farmers in Xi County; RMB 23,900 was used to support the Nutritious Meals for Children program in Nepal. At the same time, in 2021, the participants of the Great Walker initiative actively supported the Great Walker Helping Farmers Program and delivered an aid of RMB 2,506,600 through consumption, which helped increase farmers’ income.

One Yuan Donation

The “One Yuan Donation” program is a nationwide fundraising campaign jointly launched by China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation and Yum China in 2008. Every year, an event for the program is held in restaurants under Yum China’s brand such as KFC and Pizza Hut, advocating for the whole society to donate to improve the nutrition status of children in underdeveloped regions. By encouraging consumers to start from the little thing such as “giving a donation to express love”, we made it possible for everyone to participate in charity, thus promoting the concept of “everyone can be charitable”.

As of December 31, 2021, the program had raised more than RMB 230 million in total, and about 130 million person-times have participated in donation. The program has built a Philanthropy for Everyone donation platform. By the end of 2021, the “One Yuan Donation” program had benefited 800,000 children (times) from 76 counties (districts and cities) of 42 cities (prefectures) in 14 provinces (autonomous regions), including Yunnan, Guizhou, Sichuan, etc. It provided about 52.8 million servings of Nutritious Meals for students and equipped 1,261 schools with Love Kitchen equipment.

In 2021, the “One Yuan Donation” campaign was carried out in Yum China’s restaurants all over China, such as KFC, Pizza Hut, Taco Bell, Dongfang Jibai and some Little Sheep restaurants. It was simultaneously carried out in APPs, embedded programs and other online food ordering platforms of KFC and Pizza Hut, and the online channel of “V Gold Donating Love”. In order to diversify fundraising methods of the program based on previous methods, Love Coupon was launched for the first time to express thanks to the public for their donation. We sought to call on the families and children of Yum employees, upstream and downstream supply chains and external partners to participate in the program to further expand the donation. At the same time, celebrities were invited to promote and advertise for the program, which made the “One Yuan Donation” program very well known.

In 2021, the “One Yuan Donation” program raised a total of more than RMB 12 million. More than 3.11 million person-times participated in the donation.

Unite the Force for Good

The “Unite the Force for Good” is a nationwide volunteer service initiative oriented to undergraduates launched by China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation in 2011. The program encourages young undergraduates to devote 100% of their passion to philanthropy and charity, and promotes the creation of a good atmosphere for charity. The program encourages young undergraduates to devote 100% of their efforts to carry out social fundraising mobilization in the voluntary spirit to help more children in rural areas realize their dreams, which will contribute to rural revitalization. It also encourages them to devote 100% of their energy to expand their social horizons, enhance adaptability, improve overall quality, and help others while helping and improving themselves.

As of December 31, 2021, 19 sessions of “Unite the Force for Good” program have been carried out. 716,700 undergraduate volunteers of 328 colleges and universities in 127 cities of 31 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government) have participated in the program, raising a total of RMB 101.4 million., benefiting more than 670,000 primary-school students in underdeveloped areas.

In 2021, two sessions of “Unite the Force for Good” program were held. More than 60,000 college student volunteers from 148 colleges and university societies nationwide participated in the initiative. 546,300 persons were mobilized to participate in donations, and RMB 5.44 million of funds was raised, benefiting 79,000 people from 7 provinces, including Heilongjiang, Qinghai, Sichuan, Hebei, Gansu, etc. and Gelan in Ethiopia. The program delivered 25,500 Warm Packs, 224 Art Packs, and 52,407 nutritious meals to underdeveloped areas, and 1,258 food packs to the Ethiopian region.

The “Love Knows No Borders” International Charity Sale

The “Love Knows No Borders” International Charity Sale was launched in 2009 by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People’s Republic of China. In 2016, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation was invited to jointly organize the charity sale. So far, a total of over RMB 36 million has been raised. 22 convenience bridges, 7 village clinics, 1 township health center, 2 large-scale comprehensive sports fields for schools, 4 playgrounds for primary schools have been constructed in underdeveloped areas. Cochlear implants have been implanted for 127 children with congenital hearing impairment, and 50 actually fact orphans have received the care and warmth.

On December 18, 2021, the opening ceremony of the “Love Knows No Borders - Rural Revitalization, Health Care First” International Charity Sale was held in Beijing. State Councilor and Foreign Minister Wang Yi and his wife Qian Wei, Secretary of the CPC Committee of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Qi Yu, Vice Minister Le Yucheng, President of China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation Zheng Wenkai, and more than 160 representatives of foreign embassies, international organizations and enterprises attended the ceremony offline or online. In 2021, The Charity Sale was also held online due to the COVID-19. In addition to diplomatic envoys to China, the representatives of designated counties of assistance and cooperation support from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs were invited to carry out live broadcast for sale. Nearly 7 millions online participants watched the live broadcast. More than RMB 10 million was raised through the event and the funds will be used to offer necessary medical equipment for the Physical Examination Center of Jinping County People’s Hospital and Malipo County Maternal and Child Health and Family Planning Service Center, which will deliver more protection for the health of local residents.

Actions of Foreign-funded Enterprises for Rural Revitalization

To encourage foreign enterprises to better participate in the consolidation of the achievements of poverty alleviation and to effectively contribute to rural revitalization, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation and China Association of Enterprises with Foreign Investment jointly launched the "Consolidation and Revitalization-Foreign Enterprises Cohesion Action for Rural Revitalization" platform in 2019, aiming to encourage foreign enterprises to contribute to China's rural revitalization and to facilitate the Sustainable Development Goals by carrying out exchange conference and capacity building activities, such as foreign enterprises public welfare program case studies, program site visits, seminars and salons.

In 2021, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation compiled the report of "2016-2020 Poverty Alleviation Actions by Foreign-funded Enterprises in China" and hosted the "Consolidation and Revitalization-Foreign Enterprises Excellent Program Online Case Exhibition" for the first time on the 9th China Charity Fair.

In 2021, 89 foreign-funded enterprises donated more than RMB 200 million through China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation. Apple, Samsung, Starbucks, VISA, Qualcomm and other foreign enterprises carried out industrial programs in the field of industry development, such as Bona Villa and Agricultural Income-Generation Project (Shanpin E-Commerce). Wal-Mart, Yum Group, and USANA BabyCare Co., Ltd. carried out programs in the field of healthcare, such as One Yuan Donation and Nutritious Program. Nike, ABB Group, and Volkswagen Group (China) carried out programs in the field of education, such as Domestic Panda Pack Project, Charity Future, and New Great Wall Scholarship Program for Undergraduate Students. In addition, many foreign companies cooperated with us in the fields of disaster relief, rural talent training and capacity building, etc.

Running Water Initiative

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Running Water Initiative. The initiative aims to support the development of social organizations in underdeveloped areas and the introduction of social resources through institutional empowerment and the establishment of resource platforms. It helps underdeveloped areas play a role in the third distribution, and establishes an effective long-term mechanism for social forces to participate in consolidating and expanding the achievements of poverty alleviation to comprehensively promote rural revitalization.

As of December 31, 2021, the initiative had raised a total of RMB 68.7604 million in funds and supplies, benefiting 44,000 people cumulatively in 30 counties (cities, districts) of 10 cities (prefectures) in 6 provinces (municipality directly under the Central Government), including Guizhou, Sichuan, Hubei, Jiangxi, Gansu, and Chongqing.

In 2021, the initiative raised RMB 44.9402 million and spent RMB 30.78 million, benefiting 24,000 people 25 counties in 10 cities of 6 provinces, including Guizhou, Sichuan, Hubei, Jiangxi, Gansu and Chongqing.

NPO Cooperation Projects

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the NPO Cooperation Projects in 2013 in response to the lack of abilities of social organizations to solve social problems. The projects aim to facilitate social organizations to carry out programs in industrial development, talent development, rural development and social undertakings by offering comprehensive support for social organizations such as program funds and program management capacity building. They will help improve comprehensive development capacity of social organizations and serve the society with high quality.

As of December 31, 2021, the NPO Cooperation Projects have raised RMB 197.5877 million, and the total number of beneficiaries had reached 1.1013 million. The projects have benefited 583 counties (cities, districts) of 31 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government).

In 2021, the projects raised RMB 20.7019 million and spent RMB 20.87 million to support 26 social organizations, benefiting 37,700 people in 230 counties (cities, districts) of 30 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government).



The "Philanthropy for Everyone" Online Fundraising Platform

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the "Philanthropy for Everyone" Online Fundraising Platform in 2014, aiming to equip more social organizations with the ability to mobilize internet resources and to expand fundraising channels by providing social organizations with internet fundraising platform support and capacity building in program design, management, and fundraising so as to carry out high-quality charity programs.

As of December 31, 2021, the "Philanthropy for Everyone" program had raised RMB 370.796 million, benefiting 3.0382 million people in 1,101 counties (cities, districts) of 31 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government).

In 2021, the program raised RMB 26.8597 million and spent RMB 45.56 million to support 58 social organizations, benefiting 99,900 people in 221 counties (cities, districts) of 30 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government).

● "Philanthropy for Everyone" - Tencent Philanthropy Joint Fundraising Initiative

By the end of 2021, the program had raised RMB 258 million, providing public fundraising support for 2,140 programs.

In 2021, the "Philanthropy for Everyone" - Tencent Philanthropy Joint Fundraising Initiative supported 35 charity programs to participate in the "99 Charity Day" campaign, and raised RMB 13.8558 million.

● XIN Yibai Joint Charity Initiative (formerly "Goods for Good" Joint Fundraising Initiative)

By the end of 2021, the program had raised RMB 103.6 million, providing public fundraising support for 51 projects.

In 2021, the XIN Yibai Joint Charity Initiative provided public fundraising support for 2 programs, and raised RMB 2.6302 million.

Charity Future

In order to cultivate and improve charity awareness and comprehensive quality of college students, China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the “Charity Future” program in 2013. The program aims to support college students, especially those from families with financial difficulties, to carry out social practice activities in communities through integration of social resources so as to improve comprehensive abilities of college students. Focusing on the charity associations in colleges and universities and targeting at college students, the program encourages young people to contribute to social development and rural revitalization with innovative methods. Through training and practice, the program helps them become a new generation of youth who have creativity, teamwork ability and can shoulder social responsibility.

Up to December 31, 2021, the program had supported 327 associations in 198 colleges and universities in more than 30 provinces (autonomous regions and municipalities directly under the Central Government), cultivated 2,681 key leaders of the student organizations who have rich work and management experience, and had benefited more than 1.2 million young people.

In 2021, the program raised RMB 9.33 million and spent RMB 9.42 million. The program mobilized 94 charity organizations in 30 provinces (autonomous regions and municipality directly under the Central Government) to participate in charity, directly affecting 200,000 college students. 7 special projects have been carried out in total, including Mars Wrigley Waste Disposal Program, Mars Wrigley Sustainability, “Mars” GO Program, Bank of America Youth Development Program, Citigroup Youth Development Program, Talent Fund Program, Enlightening the Future-Red Flag Dream Summer Camp, 2021 Charity Future · Today at Apple Creative Studios. We also held 5 large events, including Launching Ceremony of Bank of America Youth Development Program, National Finals of Waste Disposal Program, National Launching Ceremony of Mars Wrigley Sustainability, “Mars” GO Program, and a total of 20 online training activities.

Social Enterprise Innovation

Through out 2021, the Office of the Innovation and Social Enterprise Promotion Center of CFPA has steadily rolled out projects on social enterprise innovation in terms of construction of impact investment funds, academic research and interdisciplinary engagement. The office discussed the collaboration of impact investment funds with the relevant departments in Beijing, Chengdu, Shenzhen, Guangzhou and other cities, visiting relevant enterprises. For academic research, well-known scholars were invited to carry out subject research on Research on Policy Innovation and Diffusion of Social Enterprises in China and Laws and Regulations on Social Enterprises Outside the Territory. As for interdisciplinary engagement, we held the Social Enterprise Practices Conference, and invited the government, institutions, platforms, experts and scholars to discuss how the CFPA could play a better role in the field of social innovation. During this period the CFPA has been actively promoting the concept of social innovation through industry events.

● Food Pack Distribution Program for COVID-19 Pandemic Relief

With the support from Embassy of China in Myanmar, the Myanmar Office distributed 2,584 food packs to students. The distribution has benefited three schools and families in need from two townships, which covered two states (Yangon and Kachin) and relieved people living that affected by the COVID-19 pandemic.

● Solar Lantern Program

With the support from Embassy of China in Myanmar, the Myanmar Office distributed 200 Solar Lanterns in the power shortage township of Shan State. The program has benefited 200 students and their families, which has improved their living and learning conditions.

● Prevention Materials Distribution Program Against COVID-19 Pandemic

With the support from Embassy of China in Myanmar and Bank of China (Hong Kong) Limited Yangon Branch, the Myanmar Office distributed 1,000 prevention materials packs against COVID-19 pandemic. The program has benefited 1,000 students and teachers from 12 schools at three townships in Yangon State.

● Small Oxygen Generator Donation Program for COVID-19 Pandemic Relief

The severe third-wave of the COVID-19 pandemic led to an extreme shortage of medical oxygen supply in Myanmar. In order to relieve this situation, the Myanmar Office donated 12 oxygen generator to the Sao San Htun Hospital in Shan State for the treatment of patients.

Nepal Office

● Community Quarantine Station Proram Against COVID-19 pandemic

During the outbreak of the second-wave of COVID-19 pandemic in Nepal, with the support from Giving2Asia, A Drop of Life and other organizations, the Nepal office aligned with local partners to build 15 community quarantine stations in 9 regions (Kathmandu, Janakpur, Lalbandi, Dolakha, Nawalparasi, Barpak, Doka, Kirtipur, and Pharping), equipping with medical supplies, such as oxygen cylinders, prevention supplies and community sterilization, and food pack.

● Oxygen Generator Donation Program for COVID-19 Pandemic Relief

With the donation from Pundiraka Charity, the Nepal office donated 140 oxygen generators to 50 hospitals in order to alleviate the supply shortage of oxygen under the local COVID-19 pandemic.

● Flood Disaster Relief Program

With the support from Zhejiang An foundation, Macao Meg Star Charity and Guangzhou Tianxi Buddhists Association, the Nepal Office donated food packs, gas cans and tents, beds, shoes and family first aid kit to Kathmandu and Melachi. These two regions were greatly affected by the flood disaster. The program has benefited 1,308 families and 6,500 beneficiaries.

● School Desk and Chair Support Program

With the support from local partner, the Nepal office provided Chinese residents living at Thamel in Kathmandu with 240 sets of desks and chairs in order to help the students who were affected by the COVID-19 pandemic and the flood disaster.

● Water System Construction for the Whole Village Project

With the support from A Drop of Life, the Nepal office aligned with the local partner to build a water system for Nawalparasi, Village. The project aims at relieving the water supply shortage in this community. The project invested a total of RMB 950,000, which has benefited 814 households, 4,700 people in the village.

● Youth Vocational Training Project

With the support from Laoniu Brother&Sister Foundation, the Nepal office conducted the vocational training for youth in need in five regions, such as Butwal, Chitwan, Nawalparasi, Lalitpur and Pharping. The vocational training included theoretical knowledge and practical operation of being a professional wireman and plumber. After three months of training, 156 beneficiaries found a job.

● School WASH Project

Partnering with XCMG and Splash, CFPA supports system for water storage, purifying, drinking and washing in 40 schools in Addis Ababa. In November 2021, CFPA held the completion ceremony for the first phase of 20 schools. The project not only provides children with access to clean water, it also promotes an integrated view of Water, Hygiene and Sanitation as a three-fold chord to advance health outcomes.

● "Brighten the Future" Solar Lamp Project

In 2021, the Ethiopia office launched the "Brighten the Future" Solar Lamp" Project, aiming at helping students who have difficulty to access electricity for living and learning, improving their basic living conditions, and increasing their study hours. With the help from Shenzhen Power-Solution Co., Ltd, the program distributed solar lights to 3,000 students from ten public schools in Addis Ababa and Oromia, Ethiopia.

Panda Pack Project

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation and Alibaba Philanthropy jointly launched the international Panda Pack Project in 2019. With the slogan "Gifts from the Panda Country", the program aims to improve the learning, sanitation and living conditions of the primary-school students in developing countries around China and the countries along the "Belt and Road" route by providing learning, hygiene, health and daily necessities for the student. It also aims to promote the all-round development of students, to convey the love of the Chinese people, and to build a bridge of friendship with heartfelt connectivity.

In 2021, the program raised RMB 52.63 million and spent RMB 28.31 million to support 203,600 primary-school students in 8 countries. Since launched in 2019, the program has raised a total of RMB 128 million and spent RMB 111 million. By the end of 2021, the program had benefited 935,936 primary-school students in 11 countries, including Myanmar, Nepal, Ethiopia, Cambodia, Namibia, Pakistan, Laos, Uganda, Mongolia, Zimbabwe and the Philippines.

Smiling Children Program

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation launched the Smiling Children Program in 2015 to help hungry children grow up healthily by offering meals or distributing foods. It conveys the love of the Chinese people and contributes to the building of heartfelt connectivity.

In 2021, the International Smiling Children Project further improved program management, steadily expanded the scale of school meals or food distribution to benefit more people, raised a total of RMB 10.52 million (including RMB 4.5742 million for the WFP feeding program), and spent RMB 9.54 million (including RMB 2.8786 million for the WFP feeding program). The program has benefitted 32,627 people in 6 countries including Ethiopia, Nepal, Myanmar, Pakistan, Cambodia and Laos, achieved remarkable results in hunger elimination, and has been highly affirmed and appreciated by beneficiary governments and the people.

To China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation:**I. Audit Opinions**

We have audited the attached financial statements of China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation, including the Balance Sheet as at Dec. 31, 2021, Operating Activity Statement, Cash Flow Statement and Notes to Financial Statements of Year 2021.

We believe that the attached financial statements are prepared in all major aspects as per the provisions of Accounting Rules for Non-profit Organizations, which truly reflect the financial situation of China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation as at Dec. 31, 2021, and the operation results and cash flow in the Year 2021.

II. Basis for Audit Opinions

We carried out the audit work in accordance with the Audit Rules for Chinese Certified Public Accountants. Our responsibilities under the Audit Rules are further described in Section III (Responsibility of Certified Public Accountant on Auditing Financial Statements) of the audit report below. According to the Code of Ethics for Chinese Certified Public Accountants, we are independent from China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation and have fulfilled other responsibilities in terms of professional ethics. We believe that the audit evidences we have obtained are sufficient and appropriate to provide basis for our audit opinions.

III. Responsibilities of Management and Those Charged with Governance for the Financial Statements

China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation is responsible for faithfully preparing the financial statements which achieve fair reflection as per the provisions of Accounting Rules for Non-profit Organizations, and also for designing, implementing and maintaining internal control to ensure that the financial statements are free of major misstatements caused by fraud or mistake.

IV. Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements

Our objective is to obtain reasonable assurance that the whole financial statements are free from major misstatements caused by fraud or mistake, and to produce an audit report including the audit opinion. Reasonable assurance is assurance of a high level. However, it is not assurance that audit work performed in accordance with the Audit Rules can always discover each of existing major misstatements. The misstatements may result from fraud or mistake, and are generally considered material if the misstatements could reasonably be expected to, individually or in aggregate, affect economic decisions made by users of the financial statements.

- (1) Identified and assessed the risks of material misstatements of the financial statements caused by fraud or mistake, designed and implemented audit procedures to address these risks, and obtained sufficient and appropriate audit evidence that can provide basis for giving audit opinions. Because fraud may involve collusion, forgery, willful omission, misrepresentation or overriding of internal control, the risk of failure to discover material misstatement caused by fraud is higher than that of failure to discover material misstatement caused by error.
- (2) Obtained the information on internal control related to the audit so as to design appropriate audit procedures, but the purpose is not to express our opinion on the effectiveness of the internal control.
- (3) Evaluated the appropriateness of the management's selection of accounting policies and the rationality of accounting estimates and related disclosures.
- (4) Evaluated the overall presentation, structure and content of the financial statements, and evaluated whether the financial statements fairly reflect relevant transactions and events.
